As a participant in *JA Company Program*, you can complete free online assessments that will tell you what career fields you might enjoy. After taking the assessments, you can navigate the JA Career Center for more information about your future career.

INDIVIDUAL REGISTRATION AND LOGIN INSTRUCTIONS

Please follow these instructions to begin using Kuder® Navigator. Kuder Navigator, provided by Junior Achievement, is an online educational and career planning system designed primarily for today's middle school and high school students.

REGISTRATION

Go to the JA Student Center at studentcenter.ja.org, and click **Explore Careers** in the left navigation menu.

Click **Career Assessment**.

Click **New Users Register Here** in the center of the screen. Note to teachers, volunteers, and JA staff: You may complete the assessment by registering as a student only. You do not have access registering as a Parent, Adult Job Seeker, or Administrator.

Select **Student**, and choose your grade level from the drop-down menu.

Click **Continue** to create your account.

During the registration process, you will need to create a unique user name and password.

Click **Create New Account** to complete the process.

NAVIGATOR HOME PAGE

Once you have created your account, you will be directed to your Navigator home page to access the system's tools and resources via the top navigation menu. Your home page also provides a link to your messages, assessments, recommended links, career planning timeline, and profile information.

After completing the first assessment explore your results: 6th Graders – Check out the career fields. 7-12th Graders – Use the tabs on the right:

Interest Results = top career pathways and clusters matching your interests.

Related Occupations = extensive list of job titles related to your interests.

Sample Plans of Study = detailed record of how best to proceed toward a career related to your interests.

Person Matches = career stories from real people with interests similar to yours.

To take another assessment, return to your Home page or the Learn About Myself tab.

After completing the second assessment, click **View Assessment Results** from the Learn About Myself tab. Explore your results by clicking on each of the magnifying glass icons under **Online Assessments Results**. Remember, you're looking for the career pathway or cluster and job titles you'd like to learn more about. Click **Print** near the top of the page so that you can bring your results to class.

LOGGING ON

To re-enter your lifelong account, go to the JA Student Center at **studentcenter.ja.org** and click **Explore Careers** in the left navigation menu. Click **Career Assessment**. Click **Login**, and enter your user name and password.

If you run out of time on either assessment, your responses are saved and you can complete it at a later time by returning to <http://studentcenter.ja.org/careers>, clicking on Career Assessment and logging back in with your user name and password.
