When is the event?

How much are tickets?

- Individual ticket: \$125 per adult
- Student ticket (age 7-18): Free admission
- Group Tickets: \$1,000 for 10 tickets | \$1,850 for 20 tickets

Do I need to come to the full time of the event or can I just “drop in”?

The event is planned as a drop-in format. Scheduled activities and presentations will take place at intervals throughout the evening.

What is the mask, COVID, and social distancing policy for the event?

Safety continues to be a top priority for events hosted by Junior Achievement North. Please consider the following prior to joining us at our Impact Celebration on October 27:

- If you've been exposed to Covid or are feeling ill, stay home to keep others safe.
- Masks are required indoors if you're not eating or drinking; we will also have extras at the event if you have forgotten one.
- We strongly encourage guests to be vaccinated if eligible, but we ask you to exercise social distancing while interacting with other guests and caution if that isn't possible.

Will there be food at the event?

Appetizers, sliders, and dessert. Perhaps not a full meal for everyone, but you won't leave hungry!

What should I wear to the event?

We're expecting Business-casual and Casual attire for the event. Feel free to join us right after work.

Where can I park for the event?

We're conveniently located on the Green Line light rail, just east of the Fairview station and next door to the MidwayYMCA. Our parking will be closed, with the exception of accessibility parking spots. Limited parking is available on Wheeler Street. We will have a complimentary valet service available. Carpooling and light rail are highly encouraged!

My child is 5 years old. Can I bring them to the event?

We're recommending that our student attendees be ages 7 and up. The event has been planned with an audience of adults and older kids in-mind, but your younger kid(s) may join if you think they'll enjoy themselves. Please keep in mind the above list of activities if deciding whether it's a fit.
